



## INTRODUCTION

The first full week of session was similar to the first, in that a handful of bills were filed, what took place in the Chambers was for the most part ceremonial and (with few exceptions) no votes were cast on issues of substance. The most notable event was Wednesday night's "State of the State" address, given by Governor McCrory in the House chamber and attended by legislators from both chambers, Cabinet officials and Council of State members. The Governor's speech touched on the expected main topics – jobs, education, increasing health and safety and reducing government inefficiencies. He called for an increase in starting teacher pay, a \$1.2 billion bond for transportation improvements and an overhaul of the state's IT systems. His recommendations received a relatively muted reaction from legislative leaders, with whom he will need to work, and possibly battle, to see them enacted.

Many of the bills introduced this week were relatively benign, with big-ticket items such as reforms of the state's Medicaid, tax and regulatory systems still in planning and negotiation stages. Some seemed to represent ideological statements (an increase in the minimum wage, a call for a Convention of the States to limit federal power and jurisdiction) than a serious expectation of legislative progress. One measure, which would create a bipartisan redistricting commission to draw legislative and congressional districts (and replace the completely partisan process in place) garnered support from a number of influential members of both parties in the House and generated significant media attention, but was pronounced "dead on arrival" by the powerful Senate Rules Chairman. That may change if the bill is passed by the House and is made a priority of that chamber's leadership, but the power to draw the maps – held by Democrats for over a century – may be too coveted for the majority to give up willingly.

The House and Senate Committees have been set (see below), and legislators are busy readying more legislation for introduction. We expect things to pick up next week but how quickly and for how long before the seemingly annual breakdown between the chambers takes place, remain to be seen.

## BILLS OF INTEREST

SENATE BILL 27, Reagan's Rule/Childhood Diabetes Screening, is identical to House Bill 20, summarized in the January 30, 2015, Legislative Report. **Introduced by Senator Smith and referred to the Senate Rules Committee.**

SENATE BILL 39, State Minimum Wage/Inflation Increases, would require the state to increase the minimum wage each year on January 1st starting in 2016, with the increase based on the increase in the cost of living as calculated by the Consumer Price Index (or its successor index). A minimum wage increase is one of the main priorities of the Moral Monday movement, and this fact, combined with the fact that the legislation was filed by three Democratic Senators with no Republican cosponsors, means this legislation has virtually no chance of advancement or passage even though the minimum wage has been increased above the national minimum wage in many states. **Introduced by Senators D. Davis, Lowe, and Bryant and has not yet been referred to any committee.**
